Camp will be held at the revamped Addington Manor, Buckinghamshire MK18 2JR. Addington is now under new management with the team at Addington Equestrian 2019 Limited.

**Arrival** is from 3pm on Friday 22 March and we finish on Sunday 24 March. Addington is one of the most prestigious venues in the country boasting excellent facilities together with excellent permanent onsite stabling.

**Coaches:** We have the very best coaches on hand to help you over the weekend. We have taken our time to choose coaches that are friendly, understand all levels from true grass roots to international, are current, fun and above all want you to enjoy your horse to the best of its ability. They are very experienced with each having trained a number of their own horses from young horse to Grand Prix and all have represented their own country. They coach **ALL LEVELS**.

**Workshops:** Two lectures with **Dr Alice Swetnam BVetMed MRCVS of the Buckingham Equine Clinic** who'll discuss performance in the competition horse to include management, first aid etc. **Baileys Horse Feeds** one to one consultation with **Jo Revell** to include the weigh bridge.

**Saturday night gala evening:** we're really excited to introduce you to **Tony Hobden** who has been a record producer for over 20 years and is now the face behind **Equidance**. You'll love his thoughts and presentations on **dressage to music** and how it all comes together.

**Stabling:** excellent permanent stabling is available to us. All horses and ponies will need to stable overnight or take a day stable if living locally as horses are not permitted to stand on the lorry all day. Cost is £60 for the duration of camp. **Friday afternoon arrival and welcome party:** Please arrive at Addington on the Friday from 3pm to 6pm (please advise if you will arrive later). Once settled into your stabling please come along and register with us in the cafe to collect your goody bag. We'll also confirm your timetable. We'll all meet up for the welcome drinks party and buffet from around 7.30pm. The bar will be open and you'll be able to meet with old friends and make new ones.

**Arena Familiarisation:** We know some of you like to ride when you arrive to give your horse a leg stretch and settle in so we've made arrangements for a designated arena for you to use on Friday afternoon until early evening. No lungeing.

**How much is camp and what do I get for my money?** The cost of camp is £215 and for this you'll receive a Baileys gift voucher and feed samples, goody bag, welcome glass of wine, an excellent buffet on the Friday evening, three mounted coaching sessions from some of the UK's leading international dressage riders, 2 lectures with Dr Alice Swetnam, one to one nutrition consultation and weigh bridge with Jo Revell of Baileys Horse Feeds plus the Saturday night gala with Equidance. **You can also opt to ride a test with a 5 minute feedback session from the Judge at an additional charge of £15.**

**Who can go to camp?**

**ANYONE from fourteen-years-old and above, at any level – NO MEMBERSHIP REQUIRED.**

At Central Dressage we pride ourselves on supporting all riders from those that have just started their dressage journey through to Grand Prix riders. We believe education is key. No horse under four-years-old may take part. Provided you can walk, trot and canter this camp is for you. The horses will come in all shapes and sizes from the faithful old family pony through to those aiming for National level. It will be fun, informative and you will make many friends. You can come on your own as we pride ourselves on our inclusive ethos – there will never be a dull moment – guaranteed!

**Guests:** You're very welcome to bring along partners and friends to help you and they're more than welcome to spectate ridden sessions, workshops and Saturday evening gala free of charge.

**Dogs** Your dogs can come too but we please respectfully ask they are kept on a lead at all times and you clean up after them.

**Lorries and Trailers** You'll be met on arrival on Friday from 3pm until 6pm and will be shown where to park your lorry or trailer.

**Camping** You're able to camp at Addington Equestrian free of charge.
