Stabling: quality temporary stabling is available to us. All horses and ponies will need to stable overnight or take a day stable if living locally as horses are not permitted to stand on the lorry all day. Cost is £65 for the duration of camp. Lorry parking is on hard standing and there is room for camping adjacent to the stables. Stabling is paid directly to Wellington Riding EC. Friday afternoon arrival and welcome party: Please arrive at Wellington on the Friday from 3pm to 6.30pm (please advise if you will arrive later) and once settled in come along and register with us in the reception/cafe to collect your goody bag. We'll also confirm your timetable for the Saturday. We'll all meet up for the welcome drinks party and buffet from around 7.30pm. The bar will be open and you'll be able to meet with old friends and make new ones.

How much is it and what do I get for my money?
