Stabling: quality temporary stabling is available to us. All horses and ponies will need to stable overnight or take a day stable if living locally as horses are not permitted to stand on the lorry all day. Cost is £80 for the duration of camp. There will be some bedding in the boxes already (shavings only). You are welcome to bring your own bedding or purchase directly from Wellington. Lorry parking is on hard standing and there is room for camping adjacent to the stables. Friday afternoon arrival and welcome: Please arrive at Wellington on the Friday from 3pm to 6pm (please advise if you will arrive later) and once settled in come along and register with us in the cafe to collect your goody bag. We'll also confirm your timetable for the Saturday. We'll all meet up for the welcome drinks and supper from around 7pm. The bar will be open and you'll be able to meet with old friends and make new ones.

How much is it and what do I get for my money? Please note this camp is run at cost and not for profit. The cost of camp is £245 and for this you'll receive a Baileys gift voucher and feed samples, goody bag from Equine Exceed, commemorative rosette, welcome glass of wine, supper on the Friday evening, three mounted coaching sessions from some of the UK's leading international dressage riders, 2 veterinary workshops from Scott Dunns, one to one nutrition consultation and weigh bridge with Jo Revell of Baileys Horse Feeds plus the Saturday Dressage to Music evening **You can also opt to ride a test with feedback from the Judge at an additional charge of £20. You do not have to wear competition attire.**

Who can go to camp? ANYONE from fourteen-years-old and above, at any level!

No horse under four-years-old may take part. Provided you can walk, trot and canter this camp is for you. The horses will come in all shapes and sizes from the faithful old family pony through to those aiming for National level. It will be fun, informative and you will make many friends. You can come on your own as we pride ourselves on our inclusive ethos – there will never be a dull moment – guaranteed!

Guests: You're very welcome to bring along partners and friends to help you and they're more than welcome to spectate ridden sessions, workshops and Saturday Dressage to Music evening gala free of charge.

Dogs Your dogs can come too but we respectfully ask for them to be kept on a lead at all times and that you clean up after them.

Lorries and Trailers You'll be met on arrival on Friday from 3pm until 6pm and will be shown where to park your lorry or trailer.

Camping You're able to camp at Wellington Riding EC free of charge.

Showers and Toilets There will be facilities available to us 24 hours a day

Café an excellent onsite café will be open for the duration

Closing Date: 12 August 2022 (first come first served basis)

Cost: Cost of camp is £245. Please add £20 if you wish to ride a test with feedback from the Judge. A deposit of £50 will secure your place. Full balance is due no later than 12 August 2022.
